If you are a Member with the Evaluator Plan, here are the types of services you will receive while you are trying to complete a project. The following also serves as a guideline for those who wish to act as an evaluator for a Member that has chosen the Basic Plan.

Evaluators will -

- Help direct the Member during research for a project.
- Help direct the Member with whom to call or email for a project task.
- Help the Member sort out their thoughts, choices and decision making for a project.
- Help the Member understand how their decision making process can be applied to other areas in life and be polished into effective decision making skills.
- Help the Member sort through problem solving skills.
- Help the Member apply their projects and project results to their real life.
- Help the Member balance projects with school, home life and extra-curricular activities; hence, developing good time management skills.

Next, recruit new members to Get in the Game! The sponsors will pay you an amount that you negotiate with them and they will fund the scholarship for the new members, in exchange for publicity. Hence; the sponsor's exposure increases if our membership base increases. It's advertising!
